- Marty connected with Lee at the **Vietnamese Cultural Center**. They have plans to expand to have community meeting spaces and a music program.
- Amy and Ebony are planning to start a **Campfire program** for all genders K-5th grade on Wed afternoons. Kick-off meeting November 16. Currently only open to **Sanislo** students and they would like to expand to the entire community, but they would need additional parent support(1:10 parent to kid ratio). First official activity is anticipated to occur in January.
